

Expression of interest – would you like to join the Soundtracks team?

Bolton Music Service is looking to recruit musicians to our *Soundtracks* delivery team. We work across **Bolton** and **Blackburn with Darwen**. *Soundtracks* is our programme of workshop style music sessions for young people 8 to 18, whatever their musical skill or experience. Sessions take place in youth centres and local community venues, after school, in the evenings and at weekends.

There is a focus on Rock/Pop and contemporary genres but all instrumentalists, singers & songwriters are welcome. This includes beginners.

You will support young people to:

- compose and create original music,
- put together different bands and groups with friends
- take a lead in planning performances
- have support to learn new instruments
- record and edit their work
- gain experience as a Young Leader, sharing their skills with other young people and supporting their learning

We are looking for expressions of interest from music leaders who have experience working with young people and can facilitate a multi-instrumental approach, often responding to the interests of the young people in the session. Any experience of music production/recording and of working within a youth work context would be useful, but not essential.

Support from our experienced team and the opportunity for shared delivery will be available. The rate of pay is £25/hour and an enhanced DBS will be required. Time commitment is flexible from as little as one session/week but with scope to increase hours.
